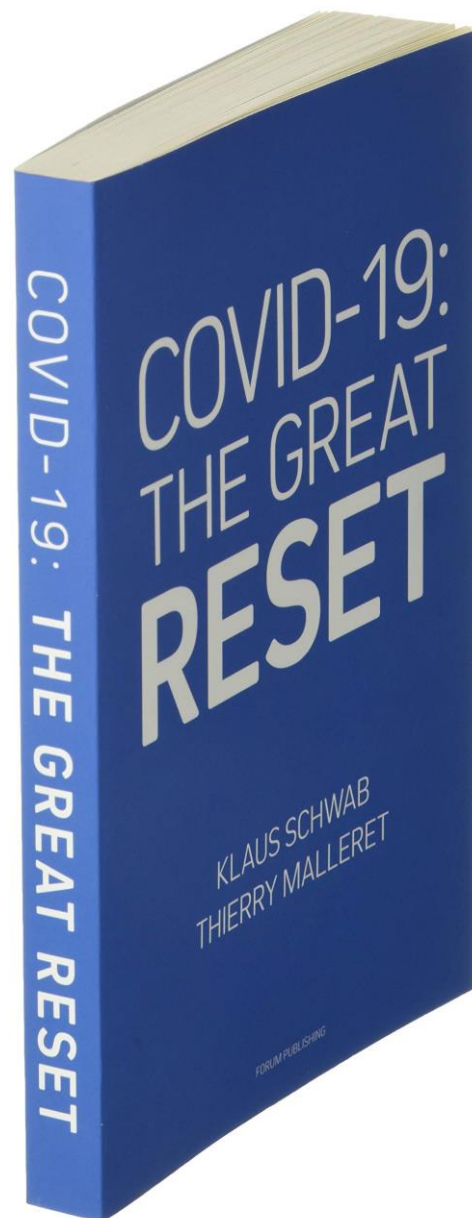


WEF – Klaus Schwab: Eerste uitgave: 13 juli 2020
