**Subject:** Request for criminal prosecution (Art. 119 Gw) / Public offences and misconduct committed by ministers, state secretaries and members of De Staten-Generaal.

Pursuant to art. 119 of the Constitution and art. 76 of the Judiciary (Organisation) Act, the Supreme Court takes cognisance in the first instance and also in the highest instance of misconduct and misconduct committed by ministers, state secretaries and members of the States General, even after their resignation.

The procedure is regulated in Article 483 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in conjunction with Articles 4-19 of the Act of 22 April 1855, Bulletin of Acts and Decrees 33, regulating the responsibility of heads of ministerial departments, which is still in force.

A prosecution of a minister in respect of official offences as referred to in art. 119 Constitution and art. 76 RO is only possible after being ordered to do so by a Royal Decree or by a decision of the House of Representatives of the States General. Citizens in the Netherlands -individually or as a group- may send a letter to their parliament to order prosecution Art.119 GW.

They can do so if they feel that the members of the House of Representatives should have issued this charge but the House of Representatives has not initiated -with at least 5 members of the House of Representatives- such a charge for prosecution.

Committing offences and complicity -acting or failing to act- committed by ministers, state secretaries and members of the States General.
