Dear legal representatives,

In the aforementioned case, the appellants have made a number of requests to the court. On behalf of the respondents, a response has been given to these requests. The court informs you regarding the requests as follows:

- Additional speaking time

The court grants the request for additional speaking time. This means that a total of 1 hour of speaking time (in the first round) is allowed for both the appellants and the respondents. The court assumes that the respondents will make arrangements among themselves regarding the division of this time.

The court will proceed based on the following schedule:

11.00	opening session
11.15-12.15	first round appellants
12.15-13.00	(lunch) break
13.00-14.00	first round of respondents (also response to the first round of appellants)
14.00-14.45	questions from the court
14.45-15.15	break
15.15-15.30	second round appellants
15.30-15.45	opportunity for representatives of appellants to speak
15.45-16.00	tweede termijn geïntimeerden
15.00-16.15	opportunity for representatives of the intimates to speak
16.15	closing of session

- Livestream

Due to the potentially high interest in this case, the court will provide a livestream. It is not possible to provide this livestream as a recording to the parties.

- Deviate from Article 2.1 of the Revised Personnel Directive

In light of the livestream to be realized, the court also sees no reason to deviate from Article 2.1 of the Revised Press Guidelines. The hearing can be followed in full by anyone via the livestream. For the sake of order in the courtroom, it is undesirable to allow anyone other than accredited press to make video or audio recordings of the hearing.

- Bring submitted witnesses/experts

The court session is a public session. The witnesses / experts presented may be present. They are also free to follow the livestream. At this stage, the court sees no reason to decide that they will be heard during this session.

The session on March 9 will focus on the admissibility of the appellants in the appeal. Whether the witnesses / experts will be heard at a later stage will depend on the decision that follows.

For the sake of a smooth hearing, the court would like to point out the following to you.

The court will hold a session in the largest courtroom available to it. In that courtroom, there are 85 seats available for the public. In addition, the session can be followed via livestream in a second courtroom (with 40 seats for the public).

Due to the number of seats available for lawyers and parties, the court would like to receive notice from you no later than two weeks before the hearing of who will be present on your side. If desired, the court can arrange a Teams connection for parties who cannot appear in person. If there is a need for this, the court would like to be informed no later than two weeks before the hearing.

If there are, besides the parties and the appointed lawyers, others whom you believe should definitely be accommodated in the main courtroom, the court would like to know, so that this can be taken into account.

Two small hearing rooms have been reserved, which can be used by parties and their lawyers prior to the hearing and during recesses of the hearing.

The court assumes that it has informed you sufficiently with this.
